CONSULTATION — EXTENDING THE SCHOOL DAY - STATUTORY REQUIREMENT FOR SCHOOLS TO BE OPEN 32.5 HOURS A WEEK FROM SEPTEMBER 2024 On Monday, a letter will be going home about the consultation period for extending the school day. From September 2024, it is statutory that schools are open 32.5 hours a week or 6.5 hours a day. Our school day is currently 15 minutes short of the required 6.5 hours. This is how we propose the school day will look:

8:35am – School gates open

8:45am – Doors to the school building are opened.

8:50am — Doors are closed. Registers are taken. Any child who enters via the school office will be marked late

3:20pm - School day finishes

The consultation will be open for 5 weeks from Monday 22nd April until Monday 20th May. Details on how to leave your comments, questions or concerns will be explained within the letter.
