<u>HEADTEACHER NEWS</u> Issue 29 of the school newsletter is coming to you on bank holiday Monday rather than the usual Friday. I hope you and your family are enjoying the extra long weekend.

YEAR 4 COLLECTIVE WORSHIP: Our Year 4 parents and carers were welcomed into school to join us for collective worship, which was expertly led by our wonderful Year 4 children. The theme was on our Christian Value of Faithfulness. The children began by explaining what faithfulness means: "Faithfulness means staying true to what you say or believe. It is about being dependable, trustworthy and loyal," before retelling the story of Abraham and Sarah from Genesis and then finishing off with 'The Faithfulness Song'. I was so impressed with how confidently the children spoke and delivered their parts. Do ask your child what they have learnt about faithfulness. Much thanks goes to Mrs Ventress and Miss Dakin for preparing the children so well.
